

**NAPE helps to bring together residents evicted by Hoima Sugar Limited and Company officials for talks.**

In 2014, hundreds of people in Kigyayo Village, Kikuube District were evicted from their land by Hoima Sugar Limited to pave way for sugarcane growing. Since then, the company officials and evictees living in camps for internally displaced people (IDPCs) have had a cat and mouse relationship. With support from NAPE, a mediation process has begun with the company officials meeting face to face with the evictees for talks aimed at getting sustainable solutions.
